

Tools for Engagement: Review Activity

Know it All

At a Glance...

This activity is designed to be a fun review for tests.

Time Required: 50 minutes

Objectives:

- Participants will gain a deeper understanding of financial concepts in preparation for testing.

Materials needed:

3" x 5" hand-held cards, each printed with a single financial concept. Two copies should be made of each card.

Prep:

Print cards creating sets of two with matching financial concepts. Label one card in each set *A* and the other *B*. For example, the concept of opportunity cost would be represented by two cards. The first would read *Opportunity Cost A* and the other would read *Opportunity Cost B*. Make sure there are enough cards for each student to draw one. If there is an odd number of students, you may become a participant.

Instructions:

Ask each student to draw a card. After everyone has drawn, instruct students to find the match to their card. The person with *Opportunity Cost A* will be looking for the person who holds *Opportunity Cost B*. Once matches are located, students will share everything they know about the subject on their cards. One match will speak first and the other may correct, clarify, or ask questions. Make sure to assign the task of first speaker in the beginning. During the first round, card *A* will speak first. During the second round the holder of card *B* will speak first, alternating turns with each new round.

Debrief:

Be sure to lead a discussion after the activity to clarify and correct any misinformation. Ask students to share out any new information they may have learned.
