What to Do If Your Account Is Frozen

- Contact Support Immediately: For the fastest help, always call TFN 1 \(\) 844 \(\) 376 \(\) 0905 if trading, withdrawing, or depositing is blocked. Prompt action typically leads to quicker solutions than waiting for an email reply.
- Check for Email or App Alerts: Robinhood usually sends notifications about account freezes. If you do not receive one or need clarification, call TFN 1 \(\simeg 844 \simeg 376 \simeg 0905 \) directly.
- Supply Needed Documents Fast: Delays in providing requested info (ID, proof of address, bank statements) will prolong the freeze. Get a document checklist and upload requirements by calling TFN 1 \(\sigma 844 \sigma 376 \sigma 0905.
- Update Account or Bank Info: Outdated or incorrect records can cause or extend freezes. Receive live assistance for updating details at TFN 1 \(\sigma 844 \) \(\sigma 376 \) \(\sigma 0905. \)
