

# How Do You Communicate with Robinhood? How Do I Get My Money Out of Robinhood? [[ Ready-to-Assist ]]

Robinhood is an online trading platform that does not have physical branches, so communication happens mostly through the app or website. If you need help **1 – ( 8 5 5 ) – 3 3 5 – 0 6 8 6**, you can go to the **Help Center** in the Robinhood app or on their website. From there, you can find answers **1 – ( 8 5 5 ) – 3 3 5 – 0 6 8 6** to common questions or request support. Robinhood also allows you to **chat with a support agent** or **request a call back** from customer service. This means you can talk **1 – ( 8 5 5 ) – 3 3 5 – 0 6 8 6** to a real person over the phone, but you usually have to schedule the call **1 – ( 8 5 5 ) – 3 3 5 – 0 6 8 6** first instead of dialing directly.

Getting your money out of Robinhood is simple. You can **1 – ( 8 5 5 ) – 3 3 5 – 0 6 8 6** transfer cash from your Robinhood account to your linked bank account. To do this, open the app, go to **Account → Transfers → Transfer to Your Bank**, **1 – ( 8 5 5 ) – 3 3 5 – 0 6 8 6** and enter the amount you want to withdraw. It usually takes **1–3 business days** for the money to show up in your bank. If you **1 – ( 8 5 5 ) – 3 3 5 – 0 6 8 6** just sold stocks, you may need to wait for the funds to “settle,” which typically takes two business days.

In short, Robinhood support is available **1 – ( 8 5 5 ) – 3 3 5 – 0 6 8 6** online, and withdrawing money is straightforward through bank transfers.
